A film about Cassie and her life during a pandemic, one of quarantine, routines, monotony, consistency, day in, day out... that is, until she runs out of coffee.

SYNOPSIS

During a mysterious pandemic, Cassie's quarantine life has turned into a routine, day in and day out. Nothing new seems to happen, until she realizes she's out of coffee. And she's *determined* to get her cup of joe, even if she must face the horrors of the outside world. Because "she'd kill for a cup of coffee." In this part-animated live action short, anything goes.

STATEMENT FROM THE DIRECTOR

This film is a test of our new 6K pixel resolution camera package which we happened to get right before the Covid-19 outbreak. We decided if we were going to do a test, we ought to create a meaningful film, one that fit in with the pandemic times. Therefore, teaming up with my longtime filmmaking partner Emile Haris, along with our lead actress, newcomer Paige Laree Poucel, we set about thinking about what life has become under quarantine – one of "routine", but one where we thought artistically outside the box, and subverted expectations, even under the 5-minute length of this film.

With additional voice talents of Alan Courtright and Bill Victor Arucan, as well as working again my longtime composer Vasilis Milesis, employing a wonderful song "The Moon and Back" sung by Ana Maria Escobar, along with DC/Marvel Comics Artist Dave Beaty who literally draws the "third act" of the film, we hope the audience will enjoy this brief yet poignant story that reflects our present realities.

We are also currently filming the sequel, a feature film called "Staycation" with our three leads reprising their roles, as well as newcomers Olivia d'Abo (Star Wars: The Rise of Skywalker, The Wonder Years, Conan the Destroyer), Sean Kenney (Star Trek: The Original Series), Tracee Cocco (Star Trek: The Next Generation, Star Trek: Deep Space Nine, Star Trek: First Contact), Eileen Dietz (The Exorcist), Kelli Maroney (Fast Times At Ridgemont High), and Laurene Landon (Maniac Cop 1 and 2).

Russ Emanuel
PRODUCER/DIRECTOR

Russ Emanuel is an award-winning American director, producer, and independent filmmaker, having directed such actors as John Heard, Robert Picardo, Vincent Pastore, Glynnis O'Connor, Hallie Kate Eisenberg, Jeremy London, Ryan Hurst, William Devane, Marina Sirtis, Sean Kenney, Armin Shimerman, and Gary Graham. He grew up in both Japan and the United States and graduated from U.S.C. to study Cinema-Television. He founded Russem Productions in 2002 to promote his films including **GIRL WITH GUN** (2005) and documentary **RESTORATION OF PARADISE** (2014). Presently, **WISPER** (2020) marks Emanuel's fifth foray into feature filmmaking, after directing **P.J.** (2007),

CHASING THE GREEN (2009), **THE LEGENDS OF NETHIAH** (2012), and **OCCUPANTS** (2015).



Emile Haris
WRITER/DIRECTOR OF PHOTOGRAPHY/EDITOR

A graduate in both Writing and Film from Long Beach State, Emile Haris, together with fellow filmmaker Yos Park, produced the sci-fi short **FRAKIE DIED** (2000). He next teamed up with University of Southern California graduate Russ Emanuel for the films **HER KNIGHT** (2003), **GIRL WITH GUN** (2005), **P.J.** (2007), **CHASING THE GREEN** (2009), **THE LEGENDS OF NETHIAH** (2012), **OCCUPANTS** (2015), **COLLAR** (2017), **THE ASSASSIN'S APPRENTICE** (2018), and now **WISPER** (2020) where he is also the Cinematographer. His other Director of Photography credits include **WHISKEY NEAT** (2009) and **HIT LIST** (2011) starring actor Joey Lawrence.



Dave Beaty
ILLUSTRATION ARTIST

David "Dave" Beaty is a professional comic book artist. He is known mostly for his work with DC Comics where he worked on several high profile series such as Batman Inc (New York Times Best Seller), Flashpoint: Wonder Woman, Brightest Day (New York Times Best Seller), and Justice League of America. On January 25, 2014 at Amazing Arizona Comicon he and a group of fellow comic book creators helped set two Guinness World Records for Fastest Time to Produce a Comic and Most Contributors to a Comic Book. More recently, in 2016, he collaborated with director Russ Emanuel on a comic book tie-in to his feature film **OCCUPANTS**.

COMPOSER

Vasilis Milesis is a multi-awarded film composer and orchestrator. He was accepted with a Scholarship and Assistantship at Berklee College of Music in the "Music for Film, TV and Games" Master Program, where he graduated with Summa cum Laude. He has worked as a music composer for many advertisements and theatrical plays. He has participated in several international film festivals and composing competitions, where he received many awards and distinctions. He is currently working closely with director Russell Emanuel, composing music for two additional shorts including **ROUTINE**, while he is also preparing a project named "Year of Humanity", his first CD with his compositions that were inspired by important facts that occurred from the previous century until now.

Residing in Akron, Ohio, Alan Courtright's voiceover experience is vast. At the age of 14, he started at his father's radio station, then moved on after graduation to work as a radio broadcast news journalist and in commercial production at several broadcasting companies across the U.S. for 27 years, all the while freelancing. His first narration was recorded at Commercial Recording in Cleveland for the Firestone 500 race produced by Impact Communications in 1976. Some of his other bigger projects included Ford, Revco, Sister's Chicken, Damon's, and Ademco. He was also one of the first podcasters in America in November 2003. More recently, he collaborated with

director Russ Emanuel on his film **OCCUPANTS** (2015).

Living in Alameda, California, Bill Victor Arucan has produced various filmmaking projects including **COMPATIBLE** (2020) where he also played an online judge, **KNUCKS** (2020), **APPETITE FOR SIN** (2021), and **CLOWN MOTEL 2** (2021), also having an acting role playing "Military Specialist 'Beef' Curry". PRODUCTION NOTES & ANECDOTES

“PETERSON NAME”

The ‘Peterson’ name is a trademark in Russ Emanuel’s films including **GIRL WITH GUN** (a casually mentioned coworker), **P.J.** (a mentioned doctor), **CHASING THE GREEN** (a field reporter), **THE LEGENDS OF NETHIAH** (a mentioned school kid), **RESTORATION OF PARADISE** (an elementary school), **OCCUPANTS** (actor Robert Picardo’s character), **COLLAR** (a mentioned kid), **THE ASSASSIN’S APPRENTICE** (a street name), and **WISPER** (another field reporter). In **ROUTINE**, the tradition continues with Bill Victor Arucan’s character ‘Rob Peterson’ (yet another field reporter).

“CHARLIE KITTY”

The cat that was drawn into the third act is actually our lead actresses Paige Laree Poucel’s cat Charlie Kitty. We thought it was a good homage to bring humanity to her character during this ongoing pandemic. It is first hinted at by her cat blanket on her bed to show what type of person Cassie is.
